The month of April saw a deficit of \$990, about \$1,500 less than our budgeted deficit. April results were better than budgeted in part because it was a 5-Sunday month and included Easter Sunday. Our year-to-day deficit is about \$5,500 less than budgeted, and as of the end of April, the Operating Fund has a balance of \$17,063.

Offerings to other funds and causes during April included <u>Then, Now, Forever Fund</u>, \$405, <u>Cause of the Month</u> (Taco Sunday), \$735, <u>Martin Fund</u>, \$1,440, and memorials added to the <u>Legacy Fund</u>, \$250. Also in April we received \$957 in offerings to the <u>Property (Loan) Fund</u> and were able to make a \$10,000 principal payment on the HVAC loan due to a large loan offering received in March.

In April we received a bequest of \$27,765 designated towards the Veterans Fund. This bequest was given to offer ministry and assistance to The Commons at Livingston (housing for homeless veterans), Honor Flight, and other veterans organizations.

Did you know that Whitehall has one of he largest Ethiopian populations in the country?

Ethiopian Tewahedo Social Services, or ETSS, offers educational, training, and developmental services for our Ethiopian brothers and sisters in the community in order to improve and facilitate more effective and comfortable integration into our community. They advocate for support and inclusion of refugees and immigrants in our society in ways that help them become self-resilient contributors to society.
