

Offerings to other funds and causes during May included <u>Then, Now, Forever Fund</u>, \$235, <u>Cause of the</u> <u>Month</u> (B.R.E.A.D.), \$450, and <u>Property (Loan) Fund</u>, \$760.

A centerpiece of this 40 works exhibition is a multi-media installation screened in a simulated sweat lodge, documenting the Montana landscape in 360-degree format, leaving the viewer immersed in aspects of Crow mythology related to the land. 
