A LETTER FROM PASTOR

With the annual meeting behind us, we are looking ahead to the next few months of strategic planning. For those unable to attend that meeting in person we are including a copy of the 2024 planning sessions in this months newsletter.

Our time of planning will be built around 1 hour sessions that follow worship in the sanctuary running from February 4th through June 2nd. It is by design that these sessions will wrap up leaving Leadership Council time to reassess the financial realities of ministries and present a July-Dec budget for congregational approval by the end of June. Our time of strategic planning is broken into 3 phases.

First, we will use February to celebrate who we are. During these sessions, we will share favorite memories of Faith, our personal call stories, and begin to consider what we want to do in the future.

Second, we will identify our internal assets, our community assets, and how the community of Whitehall is constantly evolving.

Third, we will examine the intersection of our congregational identity, core values, and assets to frame short, mid, and long term goals for ministry.

The intent of this process is to assemble a list ministries and initiatives dreamed up by the congregation, that excites the congregation about the future where God is calling us.

I do not "know the ending" that is to say what this list might contain, and that is a good thing.

What I do know is that the efficacy of this process is dependent on the participation of each and every member, as often as possible.

I know that there will inevitably be conflicts with schedules, 5 months is no meager amount of time. However, the questions being asked are "we" questions, that no one person can answer.




